Although no specific endemic or rare plant has been studied yet, the results presented in the manuscript suggest that these plants should be given more attention.</p> <p>Phytochemical screening and antimicrobial activity of four Cameroonian medicinal plant extracts against bacterial and fungal strains causing skin lesions.</p> <p>Need to improve. The English language needs to be checked.</p> <p>Too lengthy. Looks like prepared for a dissertation/thesis. The methodology needs to be more concise.</p> <p>All tests were conducted scientifically but require a scientific write-up.</p> <p>Experimental methodology references from the 1960s need to be replaced with more recent sources.</p>	
<p>Minor REVISION comments</p> <p>1. Is language/English quality of the article suitable for scholarly communications?</p>	<p>Need to improve</p>	
<p>Optional/General comments</p>	<p>Abstract:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Background need to highlight the purpose of the study. In the objective, it is enough to mention antimicrobial activity. There is no need to mention antibacterial and antifungal activities again. In Methods, not necessary to mention reference strain Numbers. Try to avoid parathas () in abstract <p>Keywords:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Two keywords separately: Secondary metabolites and primary metabolites. <p>Introduction:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> "When mentioning the name of an organism in a manuscript, write the full name for the first time and then use the short form for any further references. For example, use "<i>Escherichia coli</i>" for the first mention and then use "<i>E. coli</i>" for any repetitions." The studied plants were well known for their antimicrobial activities but no literature was provided in the introduction. <p>Methodology:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Remove the phrase "consisted of drugs" from the text as it should not be mentioned without proper testing.
