Ensure that the paragraphs flow from one to the next</p>	
<p>Optional/General comments</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> Clarity and Readability: The text is generally clear but can benefit from improved sentence structure for better readability. Some sentences are long and could be broken down for ease of understanding. Grammar and Syntax: There are minor grammatical errors and awkward phrasing that need correction. For example, "keep distinctive feature of small seed and hardy crop" should be revised to "has the distinctive feature of being a small-seeded, hardy crop." Flow and Coherence: The logical flow is present, but transitions between different points can be smoother. For instance, when introducing the geographical distribution of pearl millet production, a connecting phrase would improve the transition. Consistency: Ensure consistent use of terms and abbreviations. For example, "per cent" and "%" should be used consistently throughout the text.
