Is language/English quality of the article suitable for scholarly communications?</p>	<p>The English language and structure of the paper need to copy edited by someone who is good at English. The paper also needs editing for language and grammar. Suggest using an independent source to help with this.</p>

The references can be updated and expanded. There are some recent ones that should be discussed in the review text.
