<p><b>Minor</b> REVISION comments</p> <p>1. <b>Is language/English quality of the article suitable for scholarly communications?</b></p>	<p>In the abstract, "causing a significant reduction in yield leading to heavy losses each year depending on weather conditions" could be revised to "causing significant yield reductions and heavy annual losses, depending on weather conditions."</p> <p>In the introduction, the sentence "It has been reported to cause up to 80–85 per cent losses (Tomaz and Lima, 1986)" should specify what type of losses, e.g., "It has been reported to cause up to 80–85 percent yield losses (Tomaz and Lima, 1986)."</p>	
<p><b>Optional/General</b> comments</p>	<p>Please mention if the pathogen is a fungus and which family it belongs to. Adding picture of the morphology would be helpful. Also, please cite recent articles. I noticed all references are very old. Are there no studies done recently?</p>
