However, the even the first word of the title 'SUTAINABLE' is misspelled!</p> <p>Yes</p> <p>The subsections and structure of the manuscript are ok, but it seems mostly copied and paste from various United Nations documents!</p> <p>Not much scientific matter in this manuscript. Mostly general discussion. Many incorrect facts about SDGs and Eye care are written in the manuscript. In fact, there is no specific Eye Care goals under any of the 17 UN SDGs. However, Eye care management can be directly related to a number of UN SDGs. For example, Improved eye health reduces poverty (SDG 1) and improves productivity (SDG 8)</p> <p>References are mostly UN documents and general references. No proper scientific references are there.</p> <p>The authors should discuss more about the eye care system in Nigeria, what is the present situation and how it can be improved to fulfil the commitments as per UN SDGs.</p>

Is language/English quality of the article suitable for scholarly communications? 	<p>The overall English of the entire manuscript is poor. Lots of spelling mistakes, incomplete sentences, lack of proper formatting, and incorrect grammar usage.</p>
