This study is a case report and the use of the word association is not allowed here. It seems to be appropriate to use the word <b>comorbidity</b> instead of association.</li> <li>➤ At the end of the title, "about one case" is written, which should be written as "A case report"</li> </ul>

Are subsections and structure of the manuscript appropriate?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ The word <b>deadliest</b> is used in the introduction. This is a non-scientific term. Here is the meaning of <b>mortality rate</b>: the <b>Cause specific rate</b>, in which the denominator of the deduction includes all people in the society who are at risk of death, whether they are disease or healthy.</li> <li>➤ Or it means <b>case fatality rate</b>. In this rate, the denominator of the deduction only includes those who are disease. This rate is a measure to determine the severity of the disease.</li> <li>➤ According to the available scientific sources, it seems that the author means mortality rate. This ambiguity should be resolved.</li> </ul>

Minimum 3-4 sentences may be required for this part.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ <b>In the case report section:</b> For a case report patient, except for direct sputum smear diagnostic test, it is better to show the results of tests with higher sensitivity and specificity, such as Proportional, GeneXpert and PCR. Meanwhile, the result of the GeneXpert test is shown for the end of the treatment. These recent tests can be used both as a diagnosis and as an antibiogram. If you have the results of more valid diagnostic tests at the beginning of the treatment, state them.</li> <li>➤ <b>In the discussion section that:</b> For what reason is it said that the strain of tuberculosis bacteria was sensitive to the drug? Is it because it has been treated? This question can be answered if Proportional, GeneXpert and PCR tests were done at the beginning of the treatment for the case report of the patient. If there are results of antibiogram tests at the beginning of treatment, the name and result of the test should be mentioned.</li> </ul>
