Because the author has not highlighted the term "Extreme" as there is lot of difference between "Poverty" and "Extreme Poverty".Further the author should have should have indicated to which country (Indonesia) the study location pertains to as most readers may not know. I would suggest that the author agrees to change the title as indicated below :Analysis of : "Extreme Poverty" for the special Region of Yogyakarta in Indonesia" No need for the year 2022	
<b>3. Is the abstract of the article comprehensive?</b>	No. The Abstract is too sketchy and does not indicate why the study was essential and the focus on extreme poverty in Indonesia. Also there is no need for the word subtitle "Conclusion" in the Abstract and it would have been enough if the conclusion can be summarised in two or three lines	
<b>4. Are subsections and structure of the manuscript appropriate?</b>	No. Under the section Introduction the Authour could have explained what is Poverty and Extreme Poverty and the difference between the two scientifically accepted terms. Under the subsection Materials and Methods the author has not explained the size of the sample and which sampling methods was adopted viz., Stratified sampling, Cluster sampling, Convenience sampling or Quota sampling, simple random sampling, systemic sampling, Snowball sampling, Purposive sampling, Consecutive sampling. Further the author has not covered the Review of Literature under a separate subsection and has chosen to cover the review of literature along with the Discussion chapter.	
<b>5. Do you think the manuscript is scientifically correct?</b>	Yes the manuscript is scientifically correct.
