However, this need to be highlighted in the findings and discussion sections. 2. The title of the article needs to be rewritten. This is because the findings and conclusions on common errors are not clearly explained in terms of its relation to post pandemic and writing as well as social and cultural factors. Are you looking at common errors done by the students or the social and cultural factors that may influence the writing skill? Be consistent on this. The data collected are comprehensive. A suggestion to rewrite the section on findings and conclusions to highlight the relationship between one another. 1) What are the social and cultural factors that influence the students' writing skills? 2) Based on the analyzed written text, what are the common errors senior high school honor students commit in the post-pandemic? 3. The abstract can be improved. Do include and show the relationship between the social and culture on the students writing skills especially in the post-pandemic. 4. The subsections are satisfactorily appropriate. There should be one section to inform the connection between the social and culture with students' performance in writing. 5. The manuscript is scientifically correct. 6. Overall, the references are sufficient and recent. However, are they written in a correct citation style. Please refer to the appropriate style. If it is APA do follow the APA; if it is MLA do follow the corrected version. 7. If there was theory applied for the study do include them.

Is language/English quality of the article suitable for scholarly communications? 	<p>The quality of language for the article is suitable for scholarly communications. There are some minor grammatical errors. A suggestion to go for proofreading.</p>
