A suggested alternative title is: "Growth Dynamics and Export Potential of India's Poultry Sector: A Comprehensive Analysis"</p> <p>The abstract provides a broad overview of the study's objectives, methods, and key findings. However, it lacks clarity and some grammatical coherence</p> <p>The manuscript is well-structured with appropriate subsections for introduction, methodology, results, and discussion. However, the following improvements are suggested:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>Introduction:</b> Needs better flow and coherence, with a clearer statement of objectives.</li> <li><b>Methodology:</b> Should include a detailed explanation of the data sources and statistical methods used.</li> <li><b>Results and Discussion:</b> Should be merged for better integration of findings with the analysis.</li> </ol> <p>The manuscript appears to be scientifically sound, employing appropriate statistical techniques such as CAGR, instability indices, and Markov chain models. However, some data interpretations and statistical notations need clarity and precision. Verification of the data sources and methodologies used is essential for ensuring accuracy</p> <p>The references are relevant but not exhaustive. Including more recent studies and publications could enhance the manuscript's credibility</p> <p><b>Clarification of Objectives:</b> The objectives should be stated more clearly in the introduction to guide readers through the study's aims.  <b>Detailed Methodology:</b> Providing more details on the statistical methods and their justification would strengthen the methodological rigor.</p>
