At the end of the abstract it would be better to highlight the importance of this manuscript.</li> <li>Yes</li> <li>Yes</li> <li>The references are too few. A good review manuscript should contain at least 30 references. The study in the manuscript also shows that there are many articles related to genetically modified technology published each year, so the authors can refer to these related articles.</li> </ol> <p><b>Additional suggestions:</b> The title of this manuscript is very interesting and broad. However, the results in this article are not thoroughly discussed. The discussion needs to be more comprehensive. Questions such as i) why the trend is increasing/decreasing need to be explained, and ii) why certain countries are producing many articles related to genetically modified technology—could it be due to the prevalence of GM farms in those countries? Etc. need a major re-orientation on discussion</p>
