I suggest the change of the title to read something like the following: "Evaluating the Effectiveness of Soil-Applied Cyantraniliprole Insecticide Against <i>Bemisia tabaci</i> Infestation on <i>Solanum melongena</i> L. Leaves"</p> <p>Abstract: The abstract needs to be reformed to focus on the results clearly.</p> <p>Keywords: missing References: need to be numerated in the text. The authors used different styles through the manuscript</p> <p>Conclusions are missing. The structure of the manuscript is appropriate</p>	
<p>Minor REVISION comments</p> <p>1. Is language/English quality of the article suitable for scholarly communications?</p>	<p>The English language needs professional proof-reading throughout the manuscript.</p>	
<p>Optional/General comments</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Brinjal is known as Bazingan in Egypt (i.e. with N at the end). I suggest that the authors correct this in line 23 in the manuscript. ➤ Providing the scientific name of the insecticide cyazypyr 20% SC (i.e. Cyantraniliprole) will be more informative. I suggest that the authors add very brief information about its mode of action also. ➤ I suggest that the authors write the name of the Kalyani University clear when first mentioned and then refer to the university farm in the subsequent text. ➤ In line 62 the authors mentioned a "previous experiment" which is not provided in the manuscript. I suggest that they either elaborate somewhere or delete this mention. ➤ Spacing between words needs revision in lines: 27, 39, 86 in the attached copy ➤ In the results section: I suggest that the authors report all results in the table instead of repetition in text and in Table 1. ➤ In Table 1: I suggest that the name of the insecticide to be written once in the first cell next to the word Treatment instead of repeating it in all rows in the first column.
