

Editor's Comment:

I have read the text of the manuscript, the reviewers' reports, and a revised version of the text of the manuscript.

I consider the topic of the manuscript relevant. The research results have scientific and applied value.

At the same time, I had some comments about the text of the manuscript, namely:

1. I recommend specifying the name of the country (India) in the Abstract.
2. The material of the Introduction should be laid out more consistently. It is necessary to first describe the general situation with agriculture (in particular, with vegetables), and only then go to the data about cauliflower. In particular, the material on the first page highlighted in yellow should be moved a little further in the text. It is also advisable to divide the material of the Introduction into several paragraphs. That is, it is worth making several paragraph indents. In addition, it is not entirely clear why the authors pay so much attention to oranges in the Introduction.
3. I cannot find a reference to Table 1 in the text of the manuscript. All abbreviations should be deciphered at first mention. I ask the author(s) to make a final check of the text of the manuscript to find and eliminate possible typos and grammatical errors.

Thus, I believe that after taking into account the listed remarks, the document on the topic "Socio-Economic analysis of cauliflower growers in Jammu region of Jammu and Kashmir (UT)" can be published in the International Journal of Environment and Climate Change.
