So for use, you might just choose one of them, "Role or Potential".</p> <p>3.The abstract is good, there is background, methodology as well as results and conclusions, but it seems like the goal is not there and needs to be written clearly.</p> <p>4.The structure and subsections of this manuscript are appropriate and adequate. Each subchapter presented has clear relevance to the research topic and completeness of the required information, consistent and good flow of thought. Overall, the structure of this manuscript is very conducive to presenting the research clearly and efficiently.</p> <p>5.Based on my observations, I conclude that this text is scientifically correct.
