<p>Optional/General comments</p>	<p>It is more appropriate to give information about bilateral tension pneumothorax instead of single or double lumen endotracheal tubes in the abstract section. Brief information about the case should be provided. In the case presentation section; It should be stated how the diagnosis of bilateral tension pneumothorax was made (radiologically?, physical examination?). In the keywords section; Abbreviations should not be used and there should be a space between words. In the INTRODUCTION section; In the abstract section, the abbreviation DLT is written as DLTs here and in other parts of the article. must be corrected. Additionally, in this section, more detailed information about bilateral tension pneumothorax should be given and its difference from tension pneumothorax should be stated. In the case report section; It is appropriate to explain why a double lumen endotracheal tube is used in the mediastinoscopy procedure and why single lung ventilation is performed. because a single-lumen endotracheal tube is usually used in this procedure and there is no need for single lung ventilation. It is not understood why the patient was placed in the left lateral decubitus position and thoracoscopy was planned. The reason for mediastinoscopy should be explained to the patient with the diagnosis (subgroup determination?, response to treatment? etc.). It should be noted that free air was removed by puncture before bilateral chest tubes were inserted into the patient. In figure 1, the chest tube on the right is 5-6. It looks like it was inserted from the intercostal. Subcutaneous emphysema cannot be expected to completely resolve in one day. In the Discussion section; Reference sentence 5 should be reviewed because tension pneumothorax is a very serious condition. It was not understood why the patient was placed in the thoracoscopy position. Isn't it more appropriate to pull the double lumen tube into the trachea (further back) instead of removing the double lumen endotracheal tube and placing a single lumen endotracheal tube?</p>
