This is highly significant due to the unique geographical, cultural, and social challenges these populations face. The study's emphasis on educational technologies is timely and relevant, offering potential solutions for improved health outcomes in these underserved areas.</li> <li>The title is appropriate and clearly conveys the study's focus. However, a more specific title could enhance clarity. Suggested title: "Educational Technologies in Ophthalmology for Amazon Riverine Communities: An Integrative Literature Review."</li> <li>The abstract is generally comprehensive but could benefit from a clearer summary of the main findings and their implications. Additionally, the lack of a specific descriptor for riverine populations is crucial and should be highlighted more prominently.</li> <li>The structure and subsections of the manuscript are appropriate. The use of categories to organize the findings is effective. However, the introduction section could be more concise.</li> <li>The manuscript appears scientifically sound, with appropriate methodologies and a thorough literature review. However, the discussion could be strengthened by comparing the findings with existing studies in similar contexts.</li> <li>The references are generally sufficient and recent. However, additional recent studies on the use of educational technologies in rural health could be included.</li> </ol>
