"EXTREME VALUES AND RELIABILITY MEASURES OF CONTINUOUS ERLANG MIXTURES" is a very interesting article constructed in a well-founded and rigorous way. I draw the authors' attention to the following:

-Since the article is within the scope of "mathematical probability", authors must indicate at least one MSC. This helps to characterize the scientific scope of the article.

-At the end of the Introduction, a short text must be added that succinctly describes the structure of the rest of the article: which sections and what is done in each one.

-The Conclusions describe very well the work done. But they should also mention possible gaps or extensions that provide clues for future research.

-The text must be formatted according to the AJPAS model.
