Given the rarity of EGISTs, this case report and review are significant for both clinical practice and further research.</li> <li>The title is suitable as it accurately reflects the content of the manuscript.</li> <li>The abstract is comprehensive, but there are minor grammatical errors that need correction for clarity and readability.</li> <li>The manuscript is well-structured with clear subsections. However, the "Review of Literature" section would benefit from being more detailed and structured.</li> <li>The manuscript appears to be scientifically accurate. The case report is detailed and provides relevant clinical information. However, the review of literature could include more recent studies to enhance the manuscript's relevance.</li> <li>The references are mostly relevant and recent, but adding more up-to-date references would strengthen the manuscript.</li> </ol> <p>Abstract Improvements: Correct grammatical errors and ensure clarity. Example: "GISTS that develops outside the gastrointestinal tract and have no connection with the intestinal wall or serosal surface of the gastrointestinal tubular organs" should be revised for grammatical correctness.</p> <p>Literature Review: Expand the "Review of Literature" section to include more recent studies and provide a more comprehensive overview of EGISTs.</p>	
<p><b>Minor</b> REVISION comments</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>Is language/English quality of the article suitable for scholarly communications?</b></li> </ol>	<p>Language and Grammar: The manuscript requires minor language and grammar corrections to improve readability. Example: "Post-operative use to imatinib delay the recurrence and improves to survival rate" should be revised to "Post-operative use of imatinib delays recurrence and improves survival rate."</p>
