Consider shortening it while retaining the essential elements. For example: "Performance of BUMDes Samudera Mandiri in Enhancing Income in Marindal II Village, Deli Serdang, Indonesia".</p> <p>Here are some Suggestions:</p> <p>Specificity in Findings: While the abstract mentions the effective management and the deficit, it would benefit from a brief mention of the specific indicators met and the nature of the deficit.</p> <p>Quantitative Data: Including some quantitative data (e.g., exact deficit amount, percentage increase in income, if any) could strengthen the abstract.</p> <p>Clarification of Community Impact: The abstract states that BUMDes has only created ten new jobs but does not specify how significant this is relative to the community size.
