<p><u>Minor</u> REVISION comments</p> <p>1. Is language/English quality of the article suitable for scholarly communications?</p>	<p>The linguistic quality is quite good. Avoid using the word "baby" and prefer "infant" instead.</p>	
<p><u>Optional/General</u> comments</p>	<p>The introduction does not present general data on methamphetamine consumption in Pakistan.</p> <p>Describe precisely the child's state of consciousness at admission.</p> <p>This is an 18 month old child, how did he manage to talk to the drug specialist? Wasn't it rather his parents who spoke with the toxicologist??</p> <p>It is equally important to specify the route of administration of diazepam (IM, IV or intrarectal)</p> <p>Last sentence of "discussion" : This part is just a result already described. there is no point in putting it back here.</p>
