Yes, this work is important for the scientific community as well as for the policy makers and livestock breeders but no justification why the author is reviewing on this title or what pushes him to review on this title.</p> <p>2. Yes but needs small rearrangement "Efficiency, Challenges and opportunities of Cattle Artificial Insemination Service in Developing Countries: A Review". The economic loss should be included under the challenges section and the author should add reviewed data to be incorporated under the opportunity section.</p> <p>3. The abstract is comprehensive but the critically reviewed datas mentioned in number and percentages in the main body should be indicated here selectively. The abstract should be concise and easy to understand. The efficiencies, challenges and opportunities of AI ...should boldly come to the abstract with their number, Kg and % description. The keywords should have strengths, descriptive to the main topic contents and is better to be no more than 7 keywords.</p> <p>4. Yes but break down the tables 1, 2 and 3 considering their appropriate section in order to be visible, easy for publisher page layout and suitability of your manuscript. You can mention your subtopic as major challenges of AI and mention 1. Economic loss 2. Management problems 3. Policy problems. You should add reviewed data for the subtopic (opportunity). Arrange the conclusion and recommendation and draw concise and smart conclusion and put your recommendation in bulletin. Avoid some words available in the conclusion that are not visible in the main body of the manuscript.</p> <p>5. Yes</p> <p>6. Yes, but references under 2000 years are not relevant to your data. 80-85% of the references are from 2000-2022. Try to enrich your manuscript using recent references. Use Endnote, Wiley, APA...systems to simplify referencing your manuscript. Look to the reference section of the manuscript for minor corrections shaded by colour.</p>
