In other cases, the yellow highlight indicates a suggested correction. Additions in the text are written in red. In some cases, the yellow highlighting suggests a different formatting. The most important issue is that the author explains to the readers what is meant by 'calculated t- t- value,' 'critical t- t- value,' and 't-calculated value.' In one case ('unarguably'), it seems to me that the term is not appropriate. It is appropriate to rephrase a sentence highlighted in yellow 'students with practical work experience is gender friendly.' Sentence 4 of the Recommendations is currently in a different font from the rest of the manuscript. The last studies cited in the References, highlighted in light blue, need to be inserted into the list in alphabetical order.</p>
