Almost matches the practical results we see in daily practice</p> <p>Yes.</p> <p>--The wording of presentation of results of the study could have been better, 2nd line got somewhat confusing, "Fracture bone was found only in MDCT." --Abbreviations should have been preceded with meaning and index as is customary. --Hospital name does not show the name of the city in the whole article. Is it in India even? --There is unnecessary repetition of same fact figures and wordings, like "...gradual decrease in sensitivity as number of fractured bones increased..." 3 times at least, and "2 patients showed no fracture on x rays but 100% showed fractures on MDCT.." Twice.</p>
