I have gone through your manuscript and the reviewers' comments. However, I do not find your manuscript merits publication in our journal. There are so many issues with the way this study has been conducted. I do not understand the rationale for performing cardiac MR in all these patients. Performing cardiac MR before CABG in all comers is not the standard of care. No information is provided on the patient demographics and whether all of these patients undergoing CABG had ischemic cardiomyopathy. It is a well-known fact that scar burden correlates with risk for ventricular arrhythmias irrespective of post-CABG status.
