However, the following items require changes:</p> <p>The New Testament, particularly Jesus' teachings, must be key to addressing Christian church growth. The core of the church, according to Jesus, is both divine and human love. In other words, the New Testament reduces the ten commandments of the Old Testament to two. As a result, church expansion must address both personal and social restoration. Many churches around the world are currently forsaking their social duties in order to increase the number of church members. If a church cannot serve as light and salt in society, its function is diminished regardless of the number of members it has. Taking this into account, this work requires extensive improvement. Because the abstract is somewhat lengthy, I recommend compressing it into a more concise summary. The conclusion section should also undergo significant rearrangement, and the references section should be updated with data starting from 2000.</p>
