The manuscript does not show any new findings. Does not evaluate -why author has selected only leucorrhea patients ? what is the role of leucorrhea in HPV infection, etiologies causing leucorrhea and association with HPV infection. Is there any higher prevalence in certain type of leucorrhea. Does HPV casuse lecucorrhea. What is the prevalence of HPV in patients with non leucorrhea. It will be better patients are followed to know whether treatment of leucorrhea clear the high risk HPV infection.</li> <li>2. Title of article is Ok</li> <li>3. Abstract does not involve investigation of etiology and association with leucorrhea.</li> <li>4. Subsection and structure of manuscript are appropriate. However discussion does not reveal authors results and how it is different or similar to other authors. Nor reveal pitfalls in the study</li> <li>5. Scientifically manuscript shows prevalence of the HPV infection in leucorrhea patient however there is problem in study design as role of leucorrhea and its etiological factors in HPV infection are not evaluated. It is neither compared with prevalence in those patients with non-leucorrhoea patients, lacking the control group. It does not show how prevalence is different from overall prevalence of HPV infection in general population.</li> <li>6.
