Whereas this manuscript only talks about the concept and challenge of e-learning and ICT without any critical idea and comprehensive discussion. Also, it takes a detour to discuss the effect on the less privileged children, make it confusing what is the research object.</p> <p>There are insufficient references, and the only 18 items involved are not enough to support the author's point of view. And the format of these references also needs to be well modified.</p>
