Through the use of field data and secondary data, it is illuminating and very useful to facilitate visibility and encourage positive reflection among the parties involved and facilitate the search for solutions.</p> <p>The topic is very relevant due to the important and fundamental need to maintain and protect the cultural, artistic and existential heritage, which includes the environment and the survival of traditional ways of life, cultivation and customs, without being affected and depredated. by the tourism industry, which is usually predatory and destructive, when models such as regenerative tourism are not adopted, which generate wealth for indigenous communities, and leave possibilities for environmental conservation.</p> <p>In our case we have been able to develop heritage development and conservation programs in the Amazonas with different indigenous tribes with this tourism model that avoids exploitation and destruction and that shares the benefits with the indigenous communities.
