There are sentences where improvements are possible, such as:</p> <p>In the Introduction section, "Awal Bros Hospital" is consistently spelled as "Awal Brois Hospital." This inconsistency should be corrected for accuracy.</p> <p>In the Introduction, the sentence "Every day there are 100 newly diagnosed cases of cervical cancer which cause 57 Indonesian women to die" could be rephrased for clarity: "Every day, 100 new cases of cervical cancer are diagnosed, resulting in the deaths of 57 Indonesian women."</p> <p>The phrase "it does not show any striking symptoms or even no symptoms" in the Introduction could be clearer if written as "it may not exhibit any noticeable symptoms or may present with no symptoms at all."</p>                                                                                                                                                                                                                                     |                                                                                                                                                                                      |
