Overall, this paper presents a compelling argument for publication and will surely contribute to the field's scholarly conversation."</p> <p>Reviewing summary The research investigates the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic on Bali's economy and assesses the subsequent recovery period, focusing on the tourism sector as a key driver of economic growth. Quarterly secondary data spanning from 2018 to 2023 were analyzed, with tourist visits as the independent variable (X) and Bali's economic growth as the dependent variable (Y). The study employed descriptive statistics, qualitative descriptive analysis, and linear trend analysis to explore the dynamics of Bali's economy post-pandemic. Findings reveal a significant contraction in Bali's economy during 2020-2021 due to the adverse effects of the COVID-19 pandemic, particularly on tourist arrivals. However, post-pandemic, tourist visits began to rebound in 2022-2023, signalling a gradual recovery for the tourism-dependent economy of Bali. Despite the pandemic's impact, Bali's economic structure remained consistent, with tourism continuing to dominate. The linear trend analysis demonstrates a substantial correlation between tourist visits and Bali's economic growth, indicating that the resurgence in tourism post-pandemic has contributed significantly to economic recovery. Projections based on the analysis suggest that if tourist visits reach 1,500,000 in the first quarter of 2024, Bali's economic growth would be 6.59%. Alternatively, with 1,600,000 tourist visits in the second quarter of 2024, economic growth is estimated to reach 7.03%.</p>
