(Please write few sentences on this manuscript): The manuscript is important to the scientific community, particularly in the field of educational management. The manuscript's study of how Toraja Local Wisdom Model "Mangka Dolo Na Masiang" could improve management of diverse culture in the school setting in Indonesia makes a significant contribution to the scientific community. It also contributes to the understanding of how leadership in learning institutions can manage the various cultures that exist within schools, which is critical for successful education process.</p> <p>[2] Is the title of the article suitable? (If not please suggest an alternative title): The title of the study is generally suitable as it precisely reflects the main focus of the study. The title reflects the main variables investigated and also implies the nature of the relationships studied. However, to enhance clarity and focus, an alternative could be taken into account to improve its readability and remembrance. The new title suggested could be "School Culture Management Based on Toraja Local Wisdom Model "Mangka Dolo Na Masiang".</p> <p>[3] Is the abstract of the article comprehensive?: The abstract of the article generally provides a summary of the study with regard to the aim of the study, data collection instruments, data analysis and the results. However, to integrate all the key aspects of the abstract, it is recommended that the introduction part of the abstract should capture the aim of the study. This should be followed by the research design, data collection instruments, study population, data analysis. The key findings, conclusion and recommendation should also be mentioned. Overall, the abstract is well structured, though it could be improved by including a few of the above-mentioned additional details.</p> <p>[4] Are subsections and structure of the manuscript appropriate?: The subsections and structure of the manuscript are generally fitting for an academic research, but there are areas that could still be improved: [1] Expand Introduction: The research variables should be explained and the problem investigated should also be made more visible in the introduction. In addition, include more recent studies to demonstrate the ongoing research in this area as well as in the literature review part. [2] Research Design Clarification: Take note that the phenomenological research design used is a qualitative research design and therefore only compatible with qualitative data collection instruments such as Interviews, observation checklist and document analysis but not questionnaires. Further, clearly state the target population, sample size, data collection instruments and the ethical issues addressed in the Methodology section. [3] Enrich Discussion: Compare the research results with latest studies and discuss the implications in detail in line with the objectives of the study. [4] Update References: A more recent literature should be included to ensure that the research is relevance and align with latest research trends. [5] Visual Representation of the Model: Briefly explicate how the Toraja Local Wisdom Model 'Mangka Dolo Na Masiang' could be used to address the problem identified in the introduction and in the results. [6] Generally, the manuscript is well-structured and tackles an important topic in educational management. Improving the suggested aspects, would augment the article's impression and relevance.</p> <p>5] Do you think the manuscript is scientifically correct?: The manuscript gives the impression of a scientifically valid study in several ways based on its content and approach: This is manifested in its methodology, data analysis and interpretation of findings and conclusion within the context of educational management. However, as with any scientific study, addressing gaps mentioned in the methodology and other sections and also including its theoretical underpinning would enhance its scientific rigour.</p>
