The concept of the manuscript is important for the scientific community. It has the potential to provide information on the techniques for impacting robustness and resilience on farm animals. 2. The title is excellent. 3. Yes. 4. The structure and subsections need to be reviewed. The subheadings should be in tandem with their main headings. Factors affecting robustness and resilience should be separated from strategies for achieving robustness and resilience in farm animals. Words/vocabularies presenting the article as a manual or set of instructions should be avoided, while discussion on each section should be a summary, but detailed enough to relate to the article's title. 5. Yes, but more information is required. 6. The references are recent, but not adequate for a review work. <p>The authors need to understand that review work is like a repository of information/knowledge about the chosen title. This implies that it must contain a comprehensive information about any topic itemized in the article. All relevant literature must be cited to support the discussions.</p> | |
| <p><u>Minor</u> REVISION comments</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Is language/English quality of the article suitable for scholarly communications? | <p>Yes</p> | |
| <p><u>Optional/General</u> comments</p> | <p>3.0: The heading in this section do not adequately relate with the sub-headings. The sub-headings are more of strategies/techniques for achieving robustness and resilience.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● It will be more appropriate to discuss the factors influencing robustness and resilience under the following: 1) Genetic factors 2) Management factors, and 3) Environmental factors. Under these factors, those strategies/techniques can be discussed. It is not appropriate for a sub-heading to have the same font characteristics as the main heading, going further to underline the sub-heading gives it more prominent than the main heading. ● The information discussed under the various strategies are few. More details will be more appropriate. ● Note that sub-headings must be in tandem with the main heading. They are meant to give further and more detailed explanation to the issue/context of the main heading. ● Many sections of this article were presented in the format of a manual or a set of instructions to be carried out, this is not the posture of a review work. | |
