<p><u>Optional/General</u> comments</p>	<p>I am grateful for selecting me for review of the manuscript. I totally appreciate the efforts that have been done by the authors in presenting this case. However, the manuscript needs some major revises including:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1- In Abbreviating terms, the author sometimes uses CP and sometimes PC, which should be unified. 2- In the title of the article, treatment response with non-surgical CDT method should be emphasized (instead of the word prognosis), in addition to the rarity of the disease. 3- The author has not followed the order of referencing in the text, which needs to be corrected. The first reference is 6 and the next is 1. 4- It is suggested that at the end of the introduction part, the author should mention the main cause that reported the patient and the difference between this patient and other similar cases. it seems that, in addition to its rarity, the type of treatment method is the reason why the case is interesting and different. 5- Does the author mean "morquio" syndrome? (type 4 of mucopolysaccharidosis)? Its incidence may be related to other conditions such as Marfan Syndrome and Moquio Syndrome 6- The discussion part of the manuscript should not contain description related to the physical examination and treatment procedure undergone by the patient. These topics should be discussed in the case presentation part. The article has obvious problems in the division of 	

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	<p>different parts.</p> <p>7- it should be explained which type of pectus carinatum the mentioned patient had? Chondrogladiolar or chondromanubrial prominence?</p> <p>8- Explain whether the patient had symptoms of Marfan-Noonan-Poland syndrome or not? What were his anthropometric indicators and body proportions?</p> <p>9- Explain about the family history and the report of a similar case in the family.</p> <p>10- ‘No agenesis of upper limbs was identified.’ The term agenesis should be replaced by Upper limb abnormality.</p> <p>11- The entire sentences of the text need to be edited in terms of instructions and structure of the English language and correct phrasing.</p> <p>It is suggested that the authors provide explanations about the treatment method of CDT in introduction part.</p>
