What exactly is meant by storage conditions? Is there a method? It's not a scientific expression.</p> <p>- The powder obtained from plant material has been used in numerous analyses, but what is the reason for conducting these analyses? What does the support of the results with different literature mean?</p> <p>- The plant has an appropriate moisture content, so it can be stored for a reasonable period without spoiling." What is the moisture content, was the plant selected only because of the moisture content, if it is used in analyzes after drying, isn't it already expected for the moisture content to reach a certain level? Storage conditions were not given from the beginning, what is meant by a reasonable period?</p> <p>- <i>Sanchezia speciosa</i> has potential in drug development, but further research is needed."
