The title is suitable</li> <li>3. Yes, it is</li> <li>4. More information is required in each subsection. For example, the Author should describe clearer the ideal conservation strategies; a flowchart would be more valuable. Important factors influence it which could be controlled and uncontrolled may be explained.</li> <li>5. Yes, I do</li> <li>6. Limitation number of reference make the author does not describe the topic very well. More references should be collected.
