Minor adjustments for consistency in formatting and subsection labeling could enhance clarity.</p> <p>5. Based on the information provided, the manuscript appears scientifically correct, with clear methodology and analysis procedures supporting the findings presented.</p> <p>6. The references are sufficient, but incorporating more recent studies could strengthen the manuscript. For example, recent literature on healthcare disparities or technological advancements in trauma imaging could provide additional context and support for the study's findings.</p>
