

Editor's Comment:

I reviewed the reviewers' comments, the authors' responses, and the rewritten article. Some comments are shared by both referees. For example, the oldness of the resources is one of them. The authors have tried to add some new resources to the article, which, of course, is not enough in my opinion, but with some concessions, it is acceptable. One of the referees mentioned that it is better to change the title of the article, but I agree with the authors' answer that the current title is appropriate. However, this article still has flaws. For example, the general structure of a scientific article, which includes abstract, introduction, literature review, methodology, findings, and conclusion, is not strictly followed, and some parts such as introduction and literature review are merged together and are very brief. In addition, in the introduction part, the statement of the problem is not seen, and by the way, this issue was also mentioned by one of the referees. Therefore, I do not agree with the explanations of the authors, and I believe that every article, regardless of its characteristics and conditions, should have a clear statement of the problem. Moreover, 160 respondents are mentioned in the abstract, but 80 respondents are mentioned in the methodology. Therefore, while this inconsistency between the abstract and the methodology is evident, another point that is important to me and is mentioned in the abstract is that out of 160 respondents, only 66 answered the questions, which indicates The response rate is below 50% and this is considered a major problem in the present study.

My final opinion: If the authors of this article can make corrections in the field of modifying the overall structure of the article and fixing the above-mentioned flaws, the article can be accepted and published in the journal. But, if they are unable/unwilling to do so, or if the journal does not provide an opportunity to do this, the article will not be approved for publication in this journal.
