However, the discussion can be expanded beyond Educational Research (for example up to sociological research, etc.).</p> <p>3. Yes. The abstract of the article is comprehensive.</p> <p>4. No. The paper is not explicitly structured as a scientific paper. The Research Methodology, Findings, and Discussion of Findings are not clearly outlined.</p> <p>5. Yes. Generally, the manuscript is scientifically correct (no incorrections found).</p> <p>6. Yes.
