However, further discussion on broader implications beyond the study area could enhance its relevance to the wider scientific community. The title "Sesame Farmers' Perception of Climate Change on Sesame Production in Bade Local Government Area of Yobe State, Nigeria" is descriptive and appropriate for the content. It clearly reflects the study's focus. An alternative title could be "Assessing Climate Change Perceptions and Adaptation Strategies Among Sesame Farmers in Yobe State, Nigeria." The abstract provides a concise overview of the study's objectives, methodology, key findings, and recommendations. However, specific quantitative results (e.g., percentages, means) mentioned in the abstract could enhance clarity. Including a brief statement on the broader implications of the study findings would further enrich the abstract. Each section effectively communicates the study's objectives, methods, results, and implications. However, further elaboration on the rationale behind the selection of specific methods could strengthen the manuscript. Based on the presented data and analyses. However, providing more details on statistical methods and assumptions would enhance transparency and rigor. Clarifying the potential limitations of the study could also strengthen the manuscript. The references cited are relevant to the study's context and provide foundational support for the research. However, including recent studies (post-2015) related to climate change impacts on sesame production could strengthen the literature review and discussion. Consider referencing recent reports or studies on climate change adaptation strategies in agriculture.
