In addition to the revision comments I found the following.

- Article title still not suitable.
- Reformulate abstract indicate there are no results.
- Authors not reformulate or expand the introduction and not support it with modern references related to the aim of the study after remove the large part from the text.
- Article is still lacks the correct scientific method followed in such studies, especially there is no the materials and methods used.
- The author did not address basic scientific methods about plants and plant diseases in general.
- Author still did not not make statistical analysis to link, discuss, and review the results with other studies.
- Article include some results maybe and therefore no discussion of the treatments used, as still now in revised article there is no scientific basis to indicate the best of these treatments to increase flower and fruit quality, increase the yield of each plant and also profitability.
- References still are not sufficient for cover the topics related and not add modern references in the revised article.
- Revised article still needs to English language editor to improve the article language.
- Authors still not strictly adhere to the journal's system in standardizing and writing texts and references.

Decision

This article requires the author to do the following:

In the revised article not done the following:

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- Article revised title was no change as with red color.
- Not do what is required from to mentioned in the previous decision and from to .
- Abstract, introduction, methods and discussion are still the same.
- The revised article was still lack of scientific research methodology and the division of recognized research structures and sections.

- Revised article did not provide any new scientific addition to the scientific community or even professional agricultural development for farmers.

Thus, according to all of the wrongs above, and still present in the revised article since this article did not provide any new scientific or professional addition and is full of many scientific and linguistic errors.

Therefore,

I believe second time that this article is not suitable for publication in this journal.
