Was sedation not used, causing the patient to feel pain and move brutally?</li> <li>6. There is a spelling mistake – sinusal tachycardia?</li> <li>7. Kindly point in the figure 1 where is the RV clot</li> <li>8. Kindly elaborate on the point that post op followings were simple</li> </ol> <p>Overall, it is a rare case report, worth reporting.</p>
