

Editor's Comment:

I make an editorial decision that this manuscript is rejected for the publication in ACRI.

The comments are as follows.

1. The research focus and results in this manuscript are so limited that is not informative for international scientific community. Discussion is very poor and should be improved from the point of view of international achievements by increase of references.
2. The farmer respondents mainly involve in small-scale farmers (marginal, small and semi-medium) with less than 1ha to 4ha. They occupy 96% of total respondents. The results obtained from farm holding at a samall scale are applicable to other districts in India and also global locations or not. The authors should discuss from national and international point of view.
3. Data on mechacization index should be statistically analyzed. There is small difERENCE in mechanization index among types of farmers. Therefore, it is very important to indicate a significant difference.
4. Types of farmers are classified into marginal, small, semi mediun, medium and large farmers. However, thereis no data on larger farmers. Large farmers in Table 1 and 2 should be deleted.
5. Table 1 and 2 should be combined to only one table.
6. The number of decimal places in Table 2 should be unified. For example, 49.336, 50.1854, 51.85 in total mechanization index and other index.
