

**Editor's Comment:**

A group of disorders in which certain blood vessels or nerves are compressed. Compression of subclavian vessels and nerves of Brachial Plexus in the region of the thoracic inlet. Thoracic outlet syndrome affects the space between the collarbone and first rib (thoracic outlet). Common causes include trauma, repetitive injuries, pregnancy and anatomical defects, such as having an extra rib.

The diagnosis and management are both challenging. The condition can be detected by a simple cervical xray in case of bony compressions and an MRI cervical region is required to detect the soft tissue involvement.
