Limited Literature Review: While the case report mentions the rarity of lambdoid craniosynostosis, it could benefit from a more in-depth discussion of the existing literature on this condition. This would include a review of prevalence rates, associated symptoms, and current treatment guidelines. 2. Lack of Comparative Analysis: The case report could be enhanced by comparing the patient's presentation and outcomes to those reported in the literature. This would help to establish the uniqueness or typicality of the case. 3. Omission of Follow-up Data: The report would be more complete if it included information about the patient's post-operative course, including any complications, functional outcomes, and long-term follow-up. <p>Suggestions for Improvement</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Expand the Literature Review: Conduct a more thorough review of the literature on non-syndromic lambdoid craniosynostosis, focusing on relevant studies and meta-analyses. 2.
