It highlights gender disparities and suggests instructional technology solutions. However, its impact is limited by small sample size and shallow statistical analysis.

The study reveals a significant percentage of male pharmacists lack adequate knowledge (84.2%) and no correlation between education level and better knowledge or practice. It suggests the need for enhanced training and interactive technologies for pediatric counseling. No major deletions are necessary.

It uses a quantitative approach with statistical validation, but its generalize ability is limited by the sample size and lack of in-depth statistical analysis.

If you have suggestions of additional references, please mention them in the review form. :	The manuscript's references are relevant but outdated, especially in the rapidly evolving field of pediatric pharmacotherapy and pharmacy practices. More recent studies, such as those from the World Health Organization or American Academy of Pediatrics, could provide a more current perspective on pediatric prescription standards and the integration of technology in pediatric counseling and pharmacist training.	
Minor REVISION comments Is the language/English quality of the article suitable for scholarly communications?	Not at all.

However, improvements include improved statistical analysis, sample size expansion, and incorporating diverse references.
