The content and structure of the manuscript need to be worked on. The problem statement is not clearly defined and even the objective of the study is not clearly stated anywhere in the manuscript. The biggest problem with the manuscript is that the section #2 is repeated. However, it is not clear whether it was intentional or by mistake. If by mistake, that makes the manuscript too short to be considered as a scientific journal articles. Many of the sentences have been reiterated again and again. The statements are direct without any evidence or data. The entire manuscript is full of bullet points which makes it less scientific and more kind of generic knowledge or we can say reinventing the wheel, hence it is not qualified to be published in any scientific journal.	
Is the title of the article suitable? (If not please suggest an alternative title)	Yes, the title is interesting but the promises made in the title is not delivered in the manuscript.

Are subsections and structure of the manuscript appropriate?	No. The section should be in the format of IMRD (Introduction, Methodology, Result and Discussion) is not followed and many sub-sections have been repetitive.	
Please write a few sentences regarding the scientific correctness of this manuscript. Why do you think that this manuscript is scientifically robust and technically sound? A minimum of 3-4 sentences may be required for this part.	The manuscript does not uphold the basic rules of scientific temperament due to lack of evidence. It did not explain the methodology, how the review was done. It ignores the importance of evidence-based findings. The manuscript cannot be considered as scientific writing because it does not contain methodology section.	
Are the references sufficient and recent? If you have suggestions of additional references, please mention them in the review form. :	The references have recent but not sufficient. The author should develop a robust methodology which should contain a rigorous search strategy and inclusion exclusion criteria. For example: first the author should review in the status of nursing care including the state of nurses (recruitment, vacant seats, public private, migration of nurses etc.) then ethical challenges during pandemic should be reviewed and at the last these two should be synthesised and argument should have been built.
