In addition, the whole manuscript must be checked by native English speakers. • In the manuscript, lines and page numbers are missing, making corrections difficult. • The manuscript covers almost all the aspects of the population dynamics of Nile tilapia. <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. In the introduction of the second paragraph, it is better to mention one line about the production of Nile tilapia (i.e., quantity). 2. Were samples collected from the exact location each month or from different locations? Please clarify this briefly in the methodology section. 3. If possible, the author can mention about sampling site locations (as image). 4. In Figure 2, what Black and white colors indicate? 5. In Figure 4, L25 and L75 values (cm) should be reflected on the image itself? 6. Conclusion: write as a single paragraph. 7. In Figure 5, mention all the month names instead of mentioning one year (Horizontal axis). 8. In Figure 4, mention about the second figure. 9. The discussion part should be clear and concise, and the required changes should be made to the discussion section. And avoid more paragraphs. Around 12 paragraphs are there; merge the discussion into 5 to 6 paragraphs. 10. I found this paper" Population Dynamics of Nile Tilapia (Oreochromis niloticus, Linnaeus.1758) from Khashm El-Girba Reservoir, Atbara River, Eastern Sudan which" is more similar to this current paper". I understand that the research place is different, but the methodology looks the same as in the above-mentioned paper. Try to avoid that to minimize plagiarism. Write in your way; 11.
