I may suggest: Effect of ethanolic extracts of Carpolobia lutea on the Hippocampus of adult Wistar male rats. Histologic and Immunohistochemical study.</p> <p>There are too many details in the abstract so it is rather confusing.</p> <p>The article did NOT clarify the source of the leaves of Carpolobia lutea. From where ?? And what is the reference for making this extract? What is the reference for the donepezil the "Standard Drug"?? Sex of animals is not mentioned in materials and methods!! State that River State University is in Nijeria.</p> <p>Materials and Methods: All methods need references. Animals should be anaesthetized before cervical dislocation. It is better to use the term "histological" better than "Histopathological". Hx&E stains are very common well known techniques. So No need of all the details mentioned in the article. It is enough to mention one reference (e.g.Bancroft and Stevens, (2005)) for it and delete all these unnecessary details. (delete most in pages 8, 9 and 10.) Results: All micrographs in Fig. 1 are too pale showing no details at all. In fig 3 charactersistics is wrong spelling correct is "characteristics" . It is recommended to Not to use phrases like "it is evident" or it is "obvious"etc. It is better to be more cautious and use phrase "this study may suggest that" or the findings of this work can provide some evidence that.....etc.</p> <p>The most recent reference is 2019. This is five years ago. It is highly recommend to have more recent references in the subject. It is also recommended to write the "DOI" of each reference in the reference list.</p>
