This manuscript provides insights into the moderating role of ERP systems in the relationship between EOP and SCP in manufacturing firms in Kenya.</li> <li>2. This study is timely, given the rising importance of technology-driven solutions in supply chain to enhance efficiency and competitiveness.</li> <li>3. Its contribution to understanding how ERP strengthens SCP through EOP is useful for academic and practitioners in developing countries.</li> <li>4. However, several sections require improvements to ensure the scientific robustness and clarity of the work.</li> </ol>	
Is the title of the article suitable? (If not please suggest an alternative title)	The title captures the core of the study, mentioning the moderating effect of ERP, the dependent variable (SCP), and the geographical focus (Uasin Gishu County, Kenya).	
Is the abstract of the article comprehensive? Do you suggest the addition (or deletion) of some points in this section? Please write your suggestions here.	The abstract offers a complete overview of the study, including its objective, theoretical framework (RBT), methodology (hierarchical regression), findings, and key contributions. However, some sections are redundant and statistical details overwhelm. Suggest to remove excessive statistical values in the abstract and emphasize practical implications more clearly. (e.g; this study suggests that manufacturing firms should adopt ERP to enhance supply chain efficiency).	
Are subsections and structure of the manuscript appropriate?	The structure follows a logical flow: Introduction, theoretical framework, literature review, results, discussion, and conclusion. However, some sections need critical improvements, for example; literature review and methodology. Literature review, which provides the support for the hypotheses development, should provide a critical evaluation and cohesive synthesis rather than summarizing individual studies. No separate section for methodology is provided. Suggest to add a separate methodology section describing the selection of methods with justifications (e.g. sampling selection, data collection etc).	
Please write a few sentences regarding the scientific correctness of this manuscript. Why do you think that this manuscript is scientifically robust and technically sound? A minimum of 3-4 sentences may be required for this part.	The study uses appropriate methodologies (hierarchical regression) to examine the moderation effect. Data collection through a census approach ensures comprehensive coverage of the manufacturing firms in Uasin Gishu County. The justification for using ERP as a moderator could be more explicit. The LR briefly discusses ERP's benefits, but it lacks depth regarding why ERP should moderate the EOP-SCP relationship. Control variables (firm size and age) were analyzed, but the discussion does not explain why these specific variables were selected over others (e.g. industry type). Acknowledge limitations related to the sample's geographical scope.	
Are the references sufficient and recent? Some references are incomplete, and in-text citations do not match with the reference list. No proper refacing style is used in the Reference list (not in the alphabetical order or other).
