As the study is commissioned by the state environmental health department in Port Harcourt, kindly mention the ethical committee approval number along with funding if any.</li><li>5. There are many grammatical mistakes present in the manuscript. Please do the proofreading.</li><li>6. The table format should be properly done to properly understand the data. Do not copy the SPSS version of the table to the manuscript.</li><li>7. Study limitations can be added.</li></ol> <p>Addressing these points would enhance the manuscript.</p>
