

Editor's Comment:

I have seen the paper, but I am afraid (as it stands) is NOT SUITABLE FOR PUBLICATION.

As two reviewers, rightly, wrote “No proper citation, No Literature review”, “references are not given in text”: these were not corrected. There is not a single reference within the text: all references (n=40) located in reference list should be placed at the appropriate place of the manuscript. Recent references should be added. While the author(s) claim the “paper aims to provide a comprehensive review”, it lacks the review’s methodology (search string, keywords, inclusion/exclusion criteria, etc.) and the appropriate literature review. I have got the suspicion –certainty that the content of this paper is AI created content (e.g., from ChatGPT). Reference list is probably AI created since it does not include latest AI references.

With the spread of AI, AI-generated content constitutes an issue of academic integrity... You will make the final decision, e.g., (i) reject, or (ii) ask the authors to re-work the paper by writing it in their own words, following appropriate review methodology, and by also quoting the text produced-generated by ChatGPT/AI.
